As of January 1, 2020, 34 states have stand-your-ground laws or have expanded castle doctrine to apply beyond the home. [1] Although Utah passed the first stand-your-ground law in 1994, widespread legislative movement in this area did not begin until 2005, when Florida adopted a stand-your-ground law that became the basis for a model law adopted by the American Legislative Exchange Council.
