Highlight the source cell and then press "Ctrl-C" to copy it. Select the cell where you want the link established, click the "Paste" drop-down arrow from the Home tab's Clipboard group and then select the "Paste Link" icon. You can also press "N" when the Paste drop-down menu is activated to paste the link.

In Sheet2 type an equal symbol (=) into a cell. Go to the other tab (Sheet1) and click the cell that you want to link to. Press Enter to complete the formula.

Link Cells Between Sheets and Workbooks in Excel

Click an empty cell in your destination sheet. This will be your destination cell. When you link it to another sheet, the data in this cell will be automatically synchronized and updated whenever the data in your source cell changes. 4

How to link a cell value with a an Excel drop down list ...

In Microsoft Excel, if you enter a formula that links one cell to a cell that is formatted with the Text number format, the cell that contains the link is also formatted as text. If you then edit the formula in the linked cell, the formula is displayed in the cell rather than the value that is returned by the formula.

Enable the Developer tab. Click the Microsoft Office Button , and then click Excel Options . Click Popular , select the Show Developer tab in the Ribbon check box, and then click OK .

Find links used in formulas. Press Ctrl+F to launch the Find and Replace dialog. Click Options . In the Find what box, enter .xl . In the Within box, click Workbook . Find links (external references) in a workbook - Excel

The external reference (or link) is a reference to a cell or range in the source workbook. 3. The source workbook contains the linked cell or range, and the actual value that is returned to the destination workbook. Note: While there's no limit to the number of workbooks you can link to, it's generally a good idea to link to as few as possible.

Control when external references (links) are updated - Excel

Answer: To create a hyperlink to another cell in your spreadsheet, right click on the cell where the hyperlink should go. Select Hyperlink from the popup menu. When the Insert Hyperlink window appears, click on the "Place In This Document" on the left. Enter the text to display.

How to add a drop down list to an Excel cell

Open the Word document where the worksheet will display. Open the Excel worksheet that contains the data you want to link to the Word document. In Excel, select and copy the range of cells to include. If you plan to insert more columns or rows into the worksheet, select the entire worksheet.
